

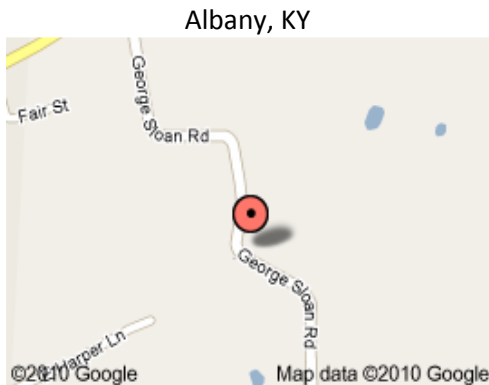
Instructions for traveling to Washington, D.C.

**Bus Three** ... Cookeville, Tennessee

Also, we advise that you bring hats and sunscreen. **What Not To Bring:** NO signs, firearms, (real or simulated), ammunition, knives, blades, or sharp objects (of any length), mace and or pepper spray, helium balloons, sticks or poles, pocket or hand tools, such as “leatherman”, packages, large bags, (larger than a backpack), weapons of any kind, aerosols, laser pointers, animals other than service/guide dogs, structures (i.e tents), **alcoholic beverages**, or any other item that may pose a threat to the security of the event.
